Leaf and Yard Waste Curbside Pick-Up: April 20th

The Spring 2013 curbside leaf and yard waste collection is scheduled for Saturday, April 20, 2013.

In order to participate in the collection, residents must place the collected leaf and yard waste materials in biodegradable paper bags at the curb prior to 7AM that day for collection (we normally encourage residents to have the bags by the curb the night before the collection).

In addition to the curbside leaf waste collection on that day, the Township will be conducting their monthly leaf and yard waste drop off collection at William F. Maule Park at Windlestrae (Main Section/Kenas Road) from 8AM to Noon. This drop-off occurs monthly on the third Saturday of every month.

Radon Awareness



Radon is a cancer-causing, radioactive gas. You can't see radon. And you can't smell it or taste it. But it may be a problem in your home. It is



estimated to cause many thousands of deaths each year. That's because when you breathe air containing radon, you can get lung cancer. In fact, the Surgeon General has warned that radon is the second leading cause of lung cancer in the United States today. Radon comes from the natural (radioactive) breakdown of uranium in soil, rock and water and gets into the air you breathe. Radon can be found all over the U.S. It can get into any type of building and result in a high indoor radon level.

Testing is the only way to know if you and your family are at risk from radon. EPA and the Surgeon General recommend testing all homes below the third floor for radon. Testing is inexpensive, easy, and should only take a few minutes of your time. If high radon levels are found, you can fix a radon problem. Radon reduction systems work and they are not very costly. Some radon reduction systems can reduce radon levels in your home by up to 99%. Even very high levels can be reduced to acceptable levels.
