Our services include fire standby for rehabilitation and safety, emergent medical care and transport of the sick and injured residents and visitors of your municipality.

When called upon, our organization also provides medical standby for public presentations and outreach.

During the month of **March 2021**, our service responded to 119 calls for service in your municipality. Of this total, 73 were transported to local hospitals. The breakdown of these transports are as follows:
