New Business:

<u>Update on Businesses in Township</u> – Each individual business owner discussed their current situation due to Covid-19. Some expressed more struggles than others based on their industry. Most local businesses have been creative in promoting their business while working remotely and must continue to do their research and learn new ways to do business in order to endure the current circumstances. The idea of promoting small local businesses with "feel good" stories and easing up on some zoning regulations on a temporary basis was discussed in order to help businesses recover and adjust to the new guidelines and restrictions due to Covid-19.

The Autumn Festival Committee will be making changes in order to minimize crowds and reduce the size of the event. The 20th anniversary will be postponed until 2021.
