
# Monthly PW Operational Highlights - May

- Armour & Sons Electric relocated a pedestrian signal at Route 309/Upper State Road for better visibility.


# **Montgomery Township EMS Zone Report**May 2024

Total Agency 911 Calls




# **Transport Disposition**
