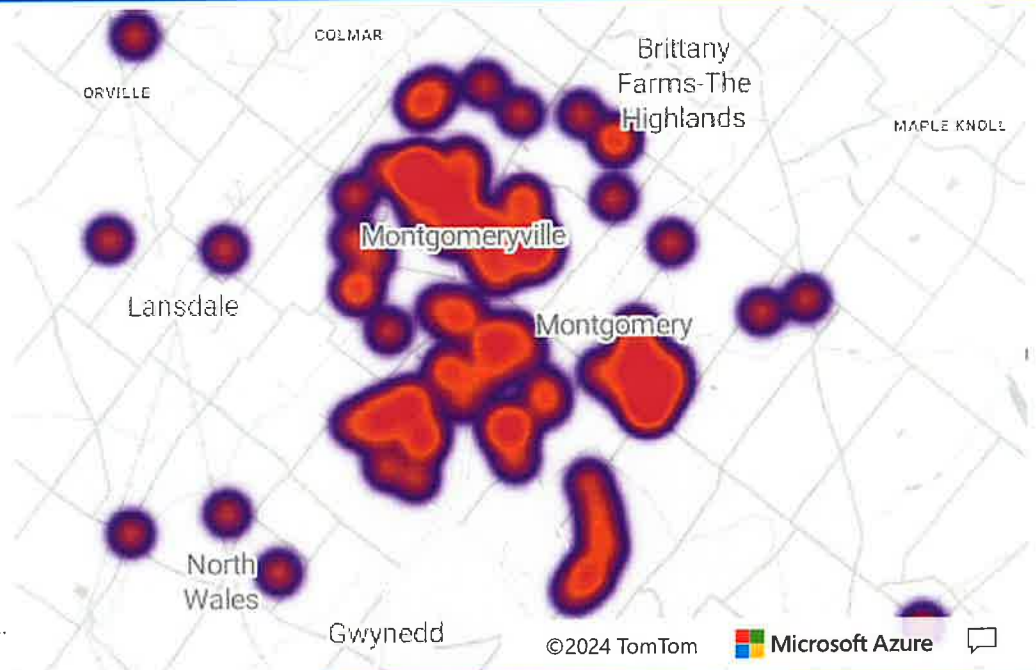
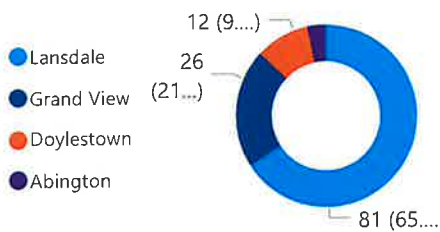

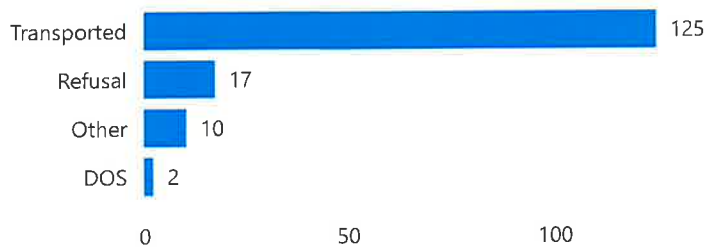

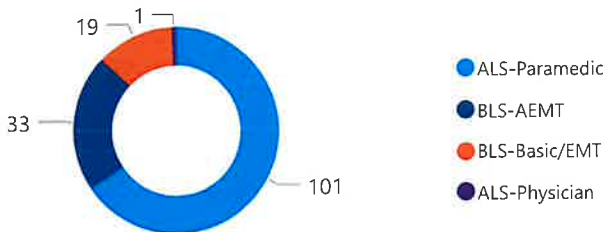
Hospital Destination



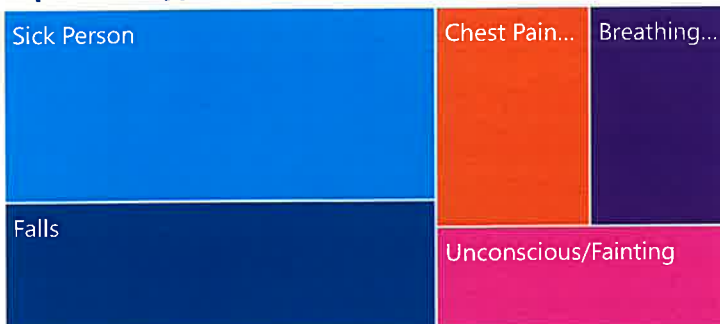
Transport Disposition



VMSC's Level of Service

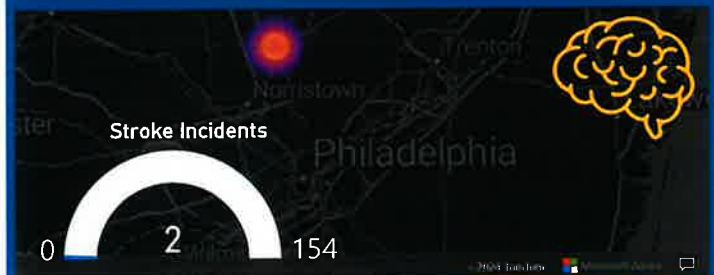


Top 5 Call Types

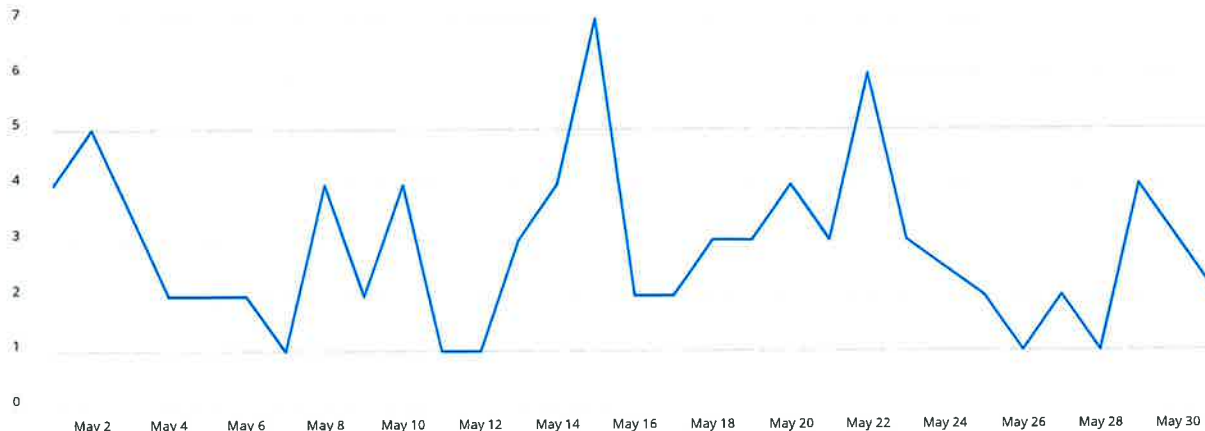
