Regular Meeting March 16, 2022

1. Chair Chuck Vesay called the regular March meeting to Order 12:15 p.m.
2. **Public Comment**
Chuck Vesay reflected on the passing of Richard Roller, former president/active community volunteer and offered a moment of silence
3. **Approval of the Minutes** (July 21, 2021, last official meeting) A motion to approve was made by Clair Bruno and seconded by Joy Zwicker. The vote was unanimous.
4. **New Business**
 - A. Committee members signed an acknowledgment of receipt of the new Committee Bylaws that were recently approved by the Board of Supervisors.
 - B. The Newly Proposed Mission Statement was presented and approved unanimously by the Committee. A copy of the document is attached.

5. Discussion Items

A) It is agreed that trying to reach our senior population is very difficult. “Getting the Word Out” will be a daunting task. Some of the obstacles and communication methods discussed:

- 1) Many are not electronically connected and some do not have up to date telephone capabilities.
- 2) The informational pamphlets which were available in the past are no longer in print. They are now available on line which makes them unavailable to a significant percentage of the population we are trying to reach.
- 3) Posting activities in grocery store Community Activity Boards.
- 4) Utilizing the bulletin boards in the public areas of Neshaminy Falls (approval will be required).
- 5) Mailing to Senior residents
- 6) A Survey.
- 7) Distribution of information at the Community Center’s various classes.

B) Senior Committee Letterhead - Joy Zwicker volunteered to create a letterhead Design for the Montgomery Township Senior Committee.

C) The final discussion item entailed the immediate focus of the Senior Committee. The consensus was to improve communication to assist senior’s awareness of the activities and services that are available for seniors in Montgomery Township. In addition, the need to discover what activities are of *interest to seniors* is very important.

D) Supervisor Audrey Ware discussed an online seminar regarding Pennsylvania Sunshine Laws. A Zoom meeting for all Volunteer Committees will be conducted April 4th, 2022 at 6:30 p.m. Further detail will be emailed to the committee members.

E) Supervisor Ware, on behalf of Montgomery Township, invited all Committee members to attend a Volunteer Appreciation Social on Thursday, May 5, 2022 at Pinecrest Country Club from 5:30pm to 8:30pm.
