March 2022 Public Safety Report for The Public Works Department

- -Crews performed routine maintenance and repairs to parks and playground equipment.
- -Drainage repairs along the walking trail at friendship park were performed.
- -4 dead trees were taken down on township property.
- -Trees branches hanging to low in the roadway were also trimmed.
- -The annual maintenance on baseball fields has begun.
- -A broken manhole frame was replaced in the roadway on Kelsey Drive.
- -Several failing areas were milled and patched on Stump road between Rt.309 and Rt.63.
- -All winter snow maintenance equipment was removed from township trucks.
- -Our semi-annual inspection of township owned basins along with routine removal of debris from storm sewers was performed to stay current with our MS4 requirements.
- -Multiple lights located at township owned facilities were upgraded to LED fixtures.
- -The crew has begun its semi-annual inspection of traffic lights.
- -Repairs were made to 3 traffic lights that had been forced into flash mode due to defects.
- -A total of 354 PA-1 calls were processed through our department.
- -There was one snow event on March 12th.


