

**Montgomery Township  
Ready For 100 Ad Hoc  
Committee  
Minutes of Meeting  
April 21, 2022**

The second meeting of the Ready For 100 Committee meeting was held on April 21, 2022, at the Montgomery Township Municipal Building. Members of the Committee in attendance included Kevin Kowalick, Paul Mau, Jon Love, Anushk Gupta, and Al Gryga. Beth Staab, Board of Supervisors' liaison & Carolyn McCreary, Township Manager were also present.

**Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 7:05 PM

**Public Comment:** None

**Introductions:**

As Mr. Gryga was unable to attend the committee's first meeting on March 24, Ms. Staab asked everyone to introduce themselves and share their backgrounds.

**Approval of the Minutes:**

A motion was made by Mr. Love and seconded by Mr. Kowalick to approve the minutes of the March 24, 2022 meeting. All voted in favor.

**Old Business:**

Ms. McCreary reported that as of March, 15 municipalities have passed renewable energy resolutions and three more communities are discussing the adoption including Lansdale Borough, Lower Gwynedd Township, and Lower Frederick Township.

Committee members reported on the municipalities they were asked to look at to evaluate what they had done as Ready For 100 early implementers. They included Abington, Whitemarsh Springfield, Cheltenham, and Plymouth Township along with Ambler, Hatboro, and Narberth Borough.

Mr. Mau described the DSIRE website which identifies incentives by state for renewables and efficiency programs.

The Committee discussed any potential overlaps in their work with the EAC, and Ms. Staab stated some of the EAC's work deals with sustainability, but this Committee is tasked specifically with addressing a transition to 100% renewable energy for the Township.

Ms. McCreary stated she would provide the Committee with an electronic copy of the energy audit and report on some of the recommended actions at the next meeting.

**New Business:**

Mr. Mau spoke about the cross-County and inter-County virtual meetings he and Mr. Love participated in. Ms. Staab stated she would provide dates of future meetings to the Committee so one or more members could participate and learn what is being done in other communities in Montgomery and Bucks County.

Going forward the Committee will meet on the fourth Thursday of the month.
