Public Works did check the signage and cut back vegetation where needed. The Police Department's Highway Safety Unit conducted a speed study of that portion of Stump Road and determined the 85th percentile speed to be 37.8 MPH. Additional speed enforcement measures will continue to be utilized to encourage motorists to obey the posted speed limit.




