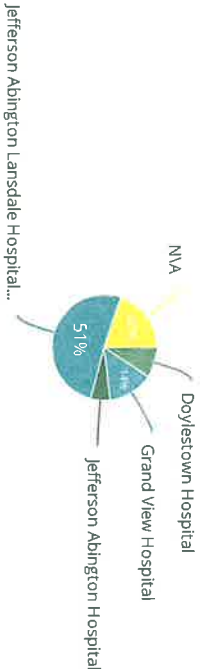

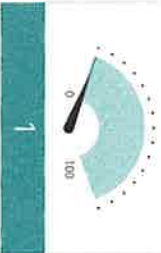

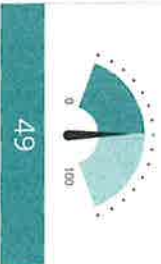
Cardiac Related Incidents

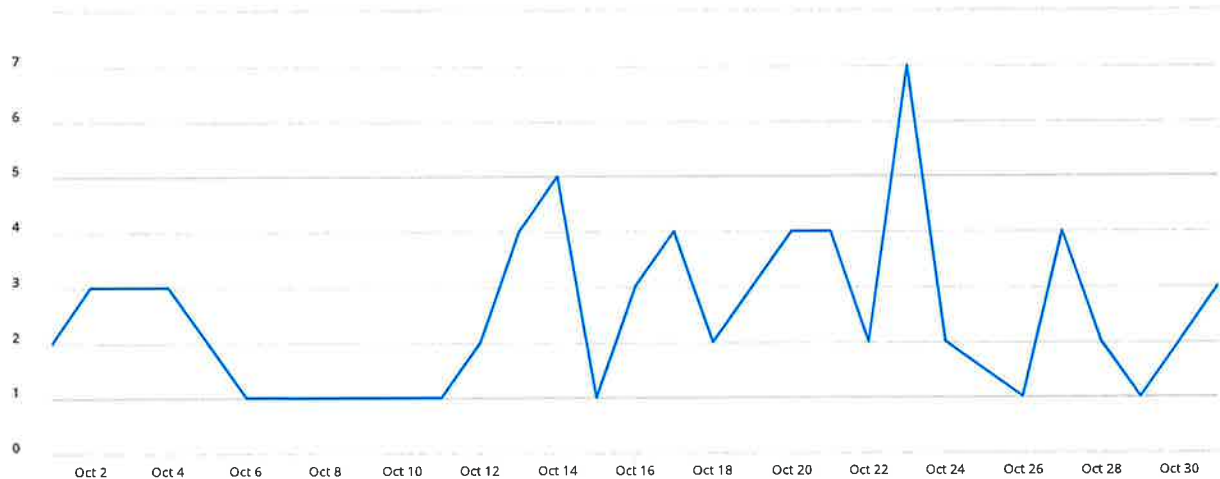
