Vehicle Crash

April 29, 2024

On 4/29/2024, at 1127 hours, Montgomery Township Police were dispatched to the Route 202 Parkway (SR0202) between Horsham Road (SR0463) and County Line Road (SR2038) for a report of a vehicle collision. While responding, Montgomery County Radio advised that the collision involved a vehicle and a commercial vehicle. It was further reported that one party had been ejected from the involved vehicle.

Arriving officers identified the involved vehicles as a purple 2017 Toyota Rav4 and a red 2021 Peterbilt 4-car hauler. A black 2006 Ford Mustang overturned in the roadway was determined to have fallen off the car hauler during the collision.

Investigation reveals that the Peterbilt was traveling northbound on Route 202, and the Toyota was traveling southbound on Route 202. The Toyota crosses over the double yellow lines and into the oncoming travel lane, at which time the driver-side front corner of the Peterbilt collides with the driver-side front corner of the Toyota.

The driver of the Toyota, a 50-year-old female from King of Prussia, PA, was ejected during the collision and pronounced deceased on scene. The passenger of the Toyota, an 86-year-old female from Ambler, PA, was extricated from the vehicle by the Fire Department of Montgomery Township and pronounced deceased on scene. The driver of the Peterbilt, a 44-year-old male from Levittown, PA, sustained suspected minor injuries and was transported from the scene by Volunteer Medical Service Corps (VMSC) to Grand View Hospital.

Montgomery Township Police were assisted by North Penn Crash Team Members from Hatfield Township Police and Towamencin Township Police, the Fire Department of Montgomery Township, Warrington Township Fire Company, North Penn Fire Company, and Colmar Fire Company.
